

Leavenheath, Polstead and Stoke by Nayland Community Woodland



Founded in 2001, the Community Woodland manages a diverse range of habitats including an old cherry orchard, rough grassland, wildflower meadow, woodland, a pond and wetlands for the benefit of local community.



Rowley Wood, Stoke by Nayland, is positioned south of the village on the road to Nayland, on land provided by The Tendring Hall Estate. Royston Wood, Leavenheath is positioned between the main settlement and the A134, on land provided by Babergh District Council.

The land is managed locally by a Steering Group who are elected at an advertised AGM in October each year.

Funding for projects has been provided by the Dedham Vale AONB Sustainable Development Fund.

The group has also helped the Stoke by Nayland Primary School refurbish its Wild Garden
